

Guidelines

In the event of inclement weather during class time and being asked to leave the pool, makeup classes cannot be provided.

1. Thunderstorm Warning:

The Observatory will indicate the areas affected by thunderstorms during a thunderstorm warning to alert pool staff to make appropriate arrangements. If the pool is open and deemed safe, classes will proceed as usual, and coaches will make the most suitable arrangements based on the pool and current conditions. Students who voluntarily miss classes that are held as scheduled due to inclement weather will be considered absent, and makeup classes will not be arranged.

* Stay updated with the latest news and arrangements from the coach and the organization.

2. Amber Rainstorm Warning and Typhoon Signal No. 1:

If public swimming pools are open, swimming classes will proceed as usual. Students who voluntarily miss classes that are held as scheduled due to inclement weather will be considered absent, and makeup classes will not be arranged.

* Stay updated with the latest news and arrangements from the coach and the organization.

* Parents should prioritize the safety of their children. If road conditions are poor, they should not proceed to attend the class.

3. Red Rainstorm Warning and Typhoon Signal No. 3:

If public swimming pools are open, swimming classes will proceed as usual. Students who voluntarily miss classes that are held as scheduled due to inclement weather will be considered absent, and makeup classes will not be arranged.

If classes are held at a club swimming pool, the organization will follow the club's arrangements.

* Stay updated with the latest news and arrangements from the coach and the organization.

* Parents should prioritize the safety of their children. If road conditions are poor, they should not proceed to attend the class.

4. Black Rainstorm Warning and Typhoon Signal No. 8:

All classes during this period will be canceled.

Students should arrange makeup classes with their coach.

* Stay updated with the latest news and arrangements from the coach and the organization.

* Parents should prioritize the safety of their children. If road conditions are poor, they should not proceed to attend the class.

* Classes scheduled within two hours before the activation of inclement weather will be canceled. Classes scheduled within two hours after the cancellation will proceed as usual.

(e.g., If the Observatory announces the expected hanging of Typhoon Signal No. 8 at 12:00 noon, all classes scheduled from 10:00 am onwards will be canceled, and coaches will be contacted to arrange makeup classes.)
